Calming Fears and Keeping Patients & Employees Safe

Capital Health Home Care Concierge utilizes rigorous infection control measures, and we will continue to do so to reduce the risk of spreading the COVID-19 virus.

- Employees will be screened daily, including temperature checks at the beginning of each day. Employees with a temperature higher than 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit will be prohibited from working and instructed to contact their physician. Any employees showing any symptoms of the virus will stop working, put on a face mask, and self-isolate at home.
- Employees are practicing infection prevention and control:
 - Washing hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or using an alcohol-based hand sanitizer if soap and water are unavailable.
 - Avoiding touching one's face (eyes, nose, and mouth) with unwashed hands.
 - Covering coughs or sneezes with a tissue and then discarding the tissue.
 - Routinely cleaning and disinfecting frequently touched objects and surfaces.
 - Wearing face masks and Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) when appropriate.
- Clients are screened at the beginning of their visits and their temperature is taken.
- COVID-19 Education Packets are being provided at Start of Care.
- Patients with the COVID-19 virus will be identified and steps will be taken to limit the transmission.
